3. **Multiple bookings – please make a block booking under one name and with one cheque.**
4. In the interests of Welfare, no horses or ponies to be kept in lorries overnight on the showground and no pens/corralls allowed.
5. Bookings are non-transferable. Please contact the Stable Manager if you no longer require your box(es)
6. All horses & ponies must be certified by a Veterinary Surgeon to be correctly vaccinated against Equine Influenza in accordance with Jockey Club regulations.
7. Passports must accompany all exhibits and are subject to spot inspection.
