## **SCOTLAND'S PREMIER SHOWING EVENT BEATS THE WEATHER**

The Scottish Horse Show committee today (14 August) announced its plans for the rescheduled 51<sup>st</sup> Scottish Horse Show, which was cancelled on Thursday 11 August due to deteriorating weather and poor ground conditions at the original venue at the Border Union Showground in Kelso.

In order to retain its crucial status as one of the country's premier and established equine showing shows and the highly prized qualifying classes for the prestigious Horse of the Year Show, the Committee has worked extremely hard to reschedule the event. The decision to move the show to Scotland's most luxurious and stunning equestrian facilities was made this weekend with the decision to fit all the scheduled classes into a two day event.

Ingliston Country Club and Equestrian Centre is only minutes from the main M8 motorway and easily accessible from the M74 and M6. "The purpose-built stabling and exceptional indoor and outdoor rings will ensure this year's show will be remembered for all the right reasons", comments Show Chairman, Tweetie Nimmo.

She adds, "The management at Ingliston House are being very accommodating and sympathetic to our plight as we did not want to disappoint the many supporters of the Scottish Horse Show who have shown great loyalty to the show over many decades. We are confident this year's show will again deliver on quality of entries forward and hope that as many exhibitors as possible take the opportunity of competing."

The show will now run over two days with the ridden horses, coloureds, Arabs and all in hand classes taking place on day one with ridden ponies, WHP, Mountain and Moorland and Intermediates taking place on day two. This year will see a supreme ridden champion from each day.
